Non-UK EU (including Ireland) or Third Country Passport Overstamp Application



All horses with valid 'third country' or non-UK EU passports (including Ireland) need to be registered on Defra's UK Central Equine Database (CED). This should be done by a UK based PIO within 30 days of the horse arriving in the UK. The UK based PIO then has the authority to make future changes to the passport such as changes of ownership, or issuing a duplicate if the passport is lost.

Overstamping costs £22.50 (£17.50 for registered equine charities).

THE BHS IS AN ID ONLY PIO, SO CANNOT OVERSTAMP PASSPORTS THAT INCLUDE DETAILS OF THE HORSE'S PEDIGREE:

Passports that contain such information must be overstamped by a UK based studbook. A list of such organisations can be found on the Gov.UK website.
